mimo is pleased to present *Ruta Inmaterial*, a two-person exhibition with works by Fabiola Burgos Labra and Jenniffer Paiz. Focusing on the exploratory forces that intersect their practices, the exhibition emanates from the intuitive call to materials, stories and happenings during their walks through public spaces.

In the ongoing project “*HUSH*”, Paiz hastily arranges fireworks between sheets of zinc, scarring the metal plates with marks that echo the volatility and intensity of the territories she transits. These happenings are frequently activated by the artist in public spaces, often sidewalks on the outside of her home, transferring, or more accurately, returning her practice to the outside. The resulting works are mirrored scores that attempt to approach contemporary and historical demonstrations of violence.

Burgos Labra’s delicately woven sculptures are suggestive structures of fragility and persistence. Using synthetic fabric commonly used for gift bows, she carefully weaves through a wire armature that holds and contradicts the softness and malleability of the ribbon material. The resulting works often present as totemic cylinders, an industrial and color-conscious structure that emanates energy from each folding of the material through the metal, softly reflecting on the viewers’ relationship to perception and material malleability.

As both artists work through ideas of approximation, visibility and substance, *Ruta Inmaterial* invites the viewer to enter a path of convergence and discovery, aiming to find a response from the path itself.
